With the vision of producing the generation of blooming buds as value based, skilled and culture oriented, Nattoja foundation Trust initiated Ambika Vidyalaya in the year 2014 with the holy blessings of Jagadguru Sri Sri Bharathi Thirtha Sannidangalu as the first ever school under CBSE stream in Puttur taluk.

A Training session were conducted for the teachers from CBSE Board on Life Skill in Bellare Jnana Ganga CBSE School. Also one day training from the CBSE Board was organised in our school on the topic Happy Class Room. Smt Sharavathi and team has taken a day's session on Yoga and Pranayama. Math Model and Concepts Training was given by Sathyamoorthy Hebbar to our math Teachers. Bharata Natya class, every Tuesday Vidushi Shilpa CH. conducts carnatic classical vocal classes, on every Thursdays Yakshagaana classes are conducted by Sri Balakrishna Uddangala & Sri Sathish Irde.

Institution has 26 trained teachers and 10 non teaching staff headed by Ms. Malathi .D as Principal and Mrs. Sujani M. Borker as Vice Principal.

In this academic year we have 459 students altogether with LKG to grade X, having single section.

Well set laboratories, library, mid day meals, school buses, games Corner are some of the facilities which the students are availing in the campus.

School offers English as first language, Kannada, Hindi and Sanskrit as remaining languages. Apart from core subjects Information Technology, drawing, "Life skill " are taught. To train the students in Yoga Smt. Sharavathi and team are assisting. Sanskara and Bhagavadgeeta are handled by Sri Shrikrishna Upadhyaya . Various hands on activities and skills are taught through the special subject Life Skill.

The teaching faculty is extending its helping hand to all those students who need extra attention and support to learn. Every day evening from 4pm to 5pm, remedial classes are conducted for such students.

The academic year began on 22nd of May. Students were warmly welcomed by the management and staff in a traditional way.

General election was held on 4th June through voting. Chi Manvith of grade X and Kumari Samskruthi of grade X were elected as Head Boy and Head Girl of the year 2022-23. Election was held for different ministries and elected students were given different portfolio in the cabinet.

On 11 June, investiture ceremony was held. Sri Aithappa Naik and Shri Rajesh Bannur were the guest of honour.

Mock Parliament is also conducted to make the students to understand the proceedings of our Parliament.

To inculcate values of land and patriotism, all national festivals, birth anniversaries of great freedom fighters are observed in the school every year. This year on the occasion of Kargil Vijay Divas, Sri Chakravarthi Soolibele graced the occasion and motivated the Ambikans with his powerful insights.

Games such as Volleyball, Throw ball, Kabaddi, Basket ball, Shuttle Badminton were conducted house wise. This year annual sports meet was organised in taluk sports ground, Kombettu and Physical Education director of first grade college Sai Sesappa inaugurated the annual meet.

Students have participated in various online and offline competitions this year and brought laurels to the institution. Ishan S Bhat and Manvith of grade X bagged third place in science quiz competition conducted by K.R.V.P. Bangalore. Srikrishna S. Nattoja secured second place in taluk level science model competition and represented our taluk in the district.

Two teams from our school got selected for INSEF regional Science fair. Kumari Khushi P.D. and Arundhathi L. Acharya presented a project work on lignin and awarded with brownz medal. Chi. Manaswith Bhandary and Chi. Abhinava Puttur worked on advanced grass cutting machine and presented the project and bagged silver medal.

Students have registered for IRIS Science project, INSPIRE award, SILVER zone Olympiad and various sports events of CBSE board. Apart from this, 15 students are going to appear for junior grade drawing examination which will be held next week.

23 students have appeared for Hindi examination conducted by Dakshina Bharath Hindi Prachar Sabha.
